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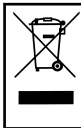
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Introduction

These release notes describe version 6.0 of the Kodak InSite Prepress Portal system.

For more information about Prepress Portal, see the Prepress Portal Help and the *InSite Prepress Portal 6.0 Quick Start Guide*.

When you are logged on to Prepress Portal, click **Help** on the toolbar to display the Prepress Portal Help.

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Hardware and software requirements

Supported Kodak workflow software

Prepress Portal 6.0 supports the following versions of Kodak software:

- Kodak Prinergy Connect or Prinergy Powerpack software 4.1.2.2 or later
- Prinergy Connect or Prinergy Powerpack software 5.0.3.1 or later
- Prinergy Connect or Prinergy Powerpack software 5.1.2.0 or later
- Prinergy Evo software 4.1.6.3 or later
- InSite Creative Workflow software 3.1.2 or later

Notes:

- To use Storefront with Prepress Portal, you must obtain a license. For more information about Storefront, see the *InSite Storefront 6.0 Release Notes*.

Supported Prepress Portal servers

Prepress Portal must be installed with the Microsoft Windows Server 2003 R2 SP2 operating system on one of the following types of Dell PowerEdge servers:

- PowerEdge 840 or T310 server
- PowerEdge 28X0, 29X0, T610, or R710 server

Note: The PowerEdge 28X0, 29X0, T610, or R710 server supports both Prepress Portal and Storefront on the same server.

Supported proxy servers

Prepress Portal supports proxy servers that use the CERN proxy protocol.

Supported client computers

If you use the Kodak Matchprint Virtual technology with your Prepress Portal system, you and your clients must use qualified and calibrated Mac computers for viewing the color of pages and surfaces accurately. For the system requirements of a Matchprint Virtual configuration, see the *Matchprint Virtual Release Notes*, which are available at <http://graphics.kodak.com/matchprintvirtual>.

For information about the supported operating systems, Sun Java, and browser software versions for client computers, see the *InSite Client Configuration Technical Bulletin*, which is available from the **Self Support > Product Documentation** page on the eCentral portal at <https://ecentral.kodak.com/>.

Note: Make sure that the version of the Java Plug-in and the JRE version on your client computer match.

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6.0.1 features and enhancements

This section lists features that were added to the Prepress Portal 6.0.1 software.

Secure links

You can set up an e-mail link to Prepress Portal that doesn't require the recipient to have a Prepress Portal account. The Secure Link feature opens a view directly into the pages that you want the recipient to review or approve, or to a Web page where the recipient can upload files to the job.

The Secure Link feature is useful for new users or occasional users who are not familiar with how to navigate in Prepress Portal and who do not need access to its full range of features.

Note: To create a secure link, your job role must include the Create Secure Link user right.

You create a secure link by clicking **Email Secure link** on either of the following tabs in the job:

- **Summary** tab: To give the user who opens the secure link access to all the pages in the job or access to a Web page for uploading files to the job
- **Pages** tab: To give the user who opens the secure link access to all the pages in the job, access only to pages that you select, or access to a Web page for uploading files to the job

You can create multiple secure links to a job and to specific pages in a job, and you can send each secure link to multiple users.

Selecting an initial display view

When you create a secure link, you select how the pages are displayed when the recipient clicks the link in an e-mail message. The following options are available:

- **HTML gallery** (selected by default): The pages appear in a Web browser. Users cannot approve the pages.
- **Flash preview:** The pages appear in a preview that allows the user to navigate easily and to zoom, rotate, pan, use Full Screen mode, and view and hide bleeds. You can allow users to approve the pages whether or not the pages are assigned to an imposition or a page set.

Note: Recipients of the secure link must have the Adobe Flash Player software installed, and you must enable preview in the job properties.

- **Smart Review:** The pages appear in Smart Review, and the full features of Smart Review are available. You can allow users to review or approve the pages.
- **File Uploader:** A Web page appears that allows the user to upload files to the job. The job's pages do not appear, and no other options are available.

Selecting options

When you create a secure link, you can enable the recipient to change the display view while viewing the pages and to download and upload files. Select from the following options:

- **Launch Flash Preview:** The recipient can view the pages in the Flash Player software. (This option is available only if the initial view is HTML gallery.)
- **Download HiRes files:** The recipient can download high-resolution versions of the pages. (This option is available only if the initial view is HTML gallery or Flash preview.)
- **Launch Smart Review:** The recipient can view the pages in Smart Review. (This option is available only if the initial view is HTML gallery or Flash preview.)
- **Upload Files:** The recipient can upload files to the job. (This option is available only if the initial view is HTML gallery.)
- **Allow user to view Preflight Data in Smart Review:** The recipient can view preflight information in Smart Review. (This option is available only if the initial view is HTML gallery, Flash preview, or Smart Review.)

Selecting rights

When you create a secure link, you can enable the recipient to approve or review pages. Select from the following rights:

- **User cannot approve or review pages** (This option is selected by default.)
- **User can approve pages**
- **User can review pages**

Expiry

By default, the secure link is set to expire after 30 days. You can change the expiry date.

Passwords

You can assign a password to the secure link. When you do, a user who clicks the secure link in an e-mail message must type the correct password before the page will appear.

Important: Provide the password to the user by phone or in a separate e-mail message. Do not include the password in the secure link e-mail message.

History

A list of all the secure links that have been created for a job appears on the **History** tab for the job (in the **Show** area, select **Secure Links**). You can delete a secure link from the list if you created the link; if a user later clicks the earlier e-mail link, the view does not open.

Automation

If you use a Prinergy Connect workflow that has the Rules-Based Automation (RBA) feature available, you can have RBA create secure links. The RBA action is called **Create Secure Link**.

Learning Center

The Learning Center gives you and your customers direct access to training videos and product documentation from within InSite Prepress Portal. Make the Learning Center part of your default theme for easy access.

Learning Center content is grouped by product and contains:

- Videos collected from many sources. Videos stream directly from the Learning Center so it is not necessary to download them.
- Product documentation—for example, system administration guides, user guides, and quick reference cards

The content for the Learning Center must be downloaded and installed separately. To locate the Learning Center content, you need to navigate to the **Self Support > Downloads** page on the eCentral portal at <https://ecentral.kodak.com/>. On the **Downloads** page, in the **Choose a Product** list, you need to select **InSite Prepress Portal**. In the **Enter search words (optional)** box, you need to type `Learning Center`, and click **Go**.

The Learning Center has been designed so that you can add your own content for staff or customers. Currently, PDF, FLV, ZIP, and SWF file formats are supported.

Adding your own content to the Learning Center

Staff users with the Configure Learning Center right can add content to the Learning Center and can change the structure. You can add your content to the existing structure of the Learning Center or create a new section with your own content and structure.

Changing the structure

Staff users can modify the structure of the Learning Center by changing the category and section names, moving them, or adding new levels.

Job properties

In the Edit Properties view in a job, staff users can select the following options to control how pages display in Prepress Portal:

- **Show View Control:** This option determines how pages display in the job by default (list view or gallery view) and whether users are allowed to change the default view for their own sessions. If you clear the check box, the **View** buttons do not appear on the **Pages** tab in the job.
- **Show Sort By Control:** This list controls how pages are sorted in the job by default (by last modified date, by position, or by signature) and whether users are allowed to change the default sort order for their own sessions. If you clear the check box, the **Sort By** list does not appear on the **Pages** tab in the job.

Tip: You can force the default view for print buyers by clearing the **Show View Control** and **Show Sort By Control** check boxes in a template job.

- **Override Page Safety Offset System Defaults:** Select this option to change the default setting for safety lines, in points, when the files in the job are viewed in Smart Review.

Note: The dimensions of safety offsets can no longer be changed in the Preferences dialog box in Smart Review. Only staff users can set safety offsets, and only in a job's **Edit Properties** view.

Preflight support

- Users can view preflight information in any language that is supported by Prinergy Connect and Prinergy Powerpack. Currently, the supported languages are English, French, German, Italian, Japanese, Korean, and Spanish.

For example, if you select French when you log on to Prepress Portal, the preflight warnings appear in French in the **Page Information** view for jobs (click *i* under a thumbnail on the **Pages** tab in the job) and in the Preflight window in Smart Review.

Note: To view preflight information, you must have a job role that includes the View Preflight Data user right.

- Preflight is now supported in a Prinergy Evo workflow.

Note: Internationalized preflight messages are only supported by Prinergy Connect or Prinergy Powerpack versions 4.1.2.1, 5.0.3.1, and later, and by Prinergy Evo version 5.1.6.2 or later.

Navigation bar

A navigation bar has been added so that users can go quickly to other locations in the Prepress Portal interface. For a staff user, the navigation bar contains the following menus:

- **Home:** Click this menu to open the home page.
- **Customers:** Click this menu to open the **Customers** view, or roll the mouse over the menu to select one of your customers from a list.
- **Manage:** Roll the mouse over this menu to select jobs, users, reports, and so on. The available items are the same as the items in the **Management** list on the Prepress Portal home page, except that customers are not available here.
- **Configure:** Roll the mouse over this menu to select upload processing rules, themes, roles, and so on. The available items are the same as the items in the **Configuration** list on the Prepress Portal home page.

A customer user may see only the **Home** and **Customers** menus, depending on the roles and rights that the user has.

Page list filters

On the **Pages** tab in a job, the **Status** filter list contains three new filters and a **Preflight Results** filter list has been added.

The following filters have been added to the **Status** filters list:

- **Reviewed - OK**
- **Reviewed - Not OK**
- **Color Approval Required**

The new **Preflight Results** filter list contains the following filters:

- **All**
- **Success**
- **Warning**
- **Error**

File names for page assignment

When a user assigns pages to positions (**Pages > Arrange Pages**), the user can have the PDF file name appear under each thumbnail. To view all the file names, click **Show Page Names** in the upper right corner.

Notes:

- The Arrange Pages feature is available only in a Prinergy Connect workflow.
- The user must have the Arrange Pages user right to view all the file names.

Flash Preview

Flash Preview now enables you to perform the following actions:

- Zoom into and out of the image
- View thumbnails of all the available pages in a single row ("film strip") below the Preview pane. Click a page in the film strip to see the page in the Preview pane.
- Move quickly between pages by using first page, next page, previous page, and last page buttons
- Go directly to a specific page by typing the page number in the box provided
- View the page state, approve or reject the page (if you have the appropriate rights), or approve the job
- Go to Smart Review
- Download high-resolution files
- View all the pages, not only pages that belong to a page set or imposition
- Use Preview in a Prinergy Evo workflow

Note: To use the Preview features, you must have the Adobe Flash Player software installed. In the Prepress Portal software, in the Job Properties window, select the **Enable Preview** check box.

Smart Review

- A user can control the default zoom level when he or she switches to a different page in Smart Review. The following options are available in the **On Change Page Zoom To** list in the *Preferences* dialog box:
 - **Minimum Size:** The next page displays in the lowest zoom level possible, based on the user's screen.
 - **Best Fit:** The next page displays in the best fit available for the user's screen.
 - **Fit To Width:** The next page displays in the full width of the user's screen.
 - **One-to-One Zoom:** The next page displays in the exact size of the file (1 inch = 1 inch).
 - **Maintain Zoom:** The next page displays in the same zoom level at which the user viewed the previous page. For example, if a user zooms to 125% when viewing a page and then opens another page, the new page displays at a 125% zoom level.
- Note:** You must view the image at 100% in order to do color-accurate proofing.
- Users can change the color of the trim lines and safety lines in Smart Review. The user right-clicks a line and selects a color from

the color palette that appears. The color of all the trim lines and the safety lines automatically changes.

Note: You can also change the line colors using the Page Info window in Smart Review (select **Window > Page Info**).

- Users can go directly to a specific page by typing the page number in the box on the bottom toolbar.
- The Smart Review system has upgraded from Adobe PDF Library version 8 to version 9. The Adobe PDF Library supports the rendering of PDF documents.

Review and approve workflow

- **Review:** Customer users cannot review pages (set the page status to Reviewed-OK or Reviewed-Not OK) unless they are specifically asked to.

To enable a customer user to review pages, select the pages in the **Pages** view, click **Request Approval**, and select **Review** beside the customer user's name.

- **Approval:** Customer users can approve pages without being specifically asked to, if the user has the Give Final Approval right.

The user selects the pages and clicks **Approve**. The message `You were not requested to approve this page` appears, but the user is able to approve the pages.

Note: Staff users can review and approve pages without being specifically asked to.

Java for Mac OS

64-bit Java is supported on Mac computers.

Note: 64-bit Java support was introduced late in the 5.5.3 release cycle.

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6.0.2 features and enhancements

This section lists features that were added to the Prepress Portal 6.0.2 software.

Approval workflow

- **Approving pages without being specifically requested to on the Pages tab:**

A warning indicator appears when users approve pages that they were not asked to approve.

An **Override Page Approval State Warnings** check box was added. When a staff user selects this check box, all the warning check boxes in all the pages that display warnings for an incorrect page approval state will be selected.

- **Approving pages without being specifically requested to in Smart Review:**

Approve/review not requested is a new area in the Preferences dialog box in Smart Review.

This new area includes a check box called **Prompt**. When the **Prompt** check box is selected, the Approve/Review confirmation window appears for a user who did not receive a request to approve a page.

Note: The **Prompt** check box is selected by default.

When the **Prompt** check box is cleared, the user can approve a page without being specifically asked to, and the user does not have to confirm this action.

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Limitations

Brisque software

Prepress Portal 6.0 or later does not support the Kodak Brisque software.

Java software

On Microsoft Windows operating systems, Prepress Portal supports only the Sun Java software.

Switching to a specific page in Preview's full screen mode

In full screen mode in Preview, the option to go to a certain page number is unavailable. The Adobe Flash software does not allow text entry in full screen mode; this is a security feature of the Flash software.

Full screen mode crashes the browser software

A known Adobe Flash issue causes the Microsoft Internet Explorer browser software to crash when a user views files in Preview's full screen mode using the Microsoft Windows operating system.

To fix this issue, before using the full screen mode the user must right-click the Flash player window, select **Settings**, clear the **Enable hardware acceleration** check box, and click **Close**.

(Prinerger Connect workflow only) Spot colors must be defined in the Prinerger color libraries

To guarantee color fidelity and an unambiguous color definition, Prepress Portal uses only LAB recipes for custom spot colors.

To view custom spot colors in Smart Review, the colors must be defined in the Prinerger SystemLab or Lab2000 color libraries. If a custom spot color is defined in another color space or library, the color will appear as grey in Smart Review.

If the SystemLab library does not already exist, you can create it, and add your custom spot color recipes to it. You must use the correct mixed-case name (SystemLab), and you must use an LAB color space.

Uploads with UNIX file servers

Uploading files from a Mac computer when the job is stored on a Samba The Open Group UNIX file share may cause the font resource forks to be lost.

Server names

Prepress Portal server names cannot contain the character “_” (underscore). Microsoft strictly enforces domain name restrictions in order to prevent malicious Web sites from accessing cookies from another site.

Incorrect: `http://oregon_plant.printer.com`

Correct: `http://oregon-plant.printer.com`

Prepress Portal in a frameset

Placing Prepress Portal in an HTML frameset is not supported.

RIP for rendering proofs in versioned jobs

Prepress Portal does not support RIP for rendering proofs in versioned jobs. The **Enable Rip for Rendering Proofs** check box must be cleared in the job’s properties.

Impact fonts and Adobe Print Engine

When creating final output (for plates or the Kodak Prinergy Virtual Proofing System software) of jobs that use the **Impact** font, you must RIP with Adobe Print Engine in Prinergy.

RBA actions

The Rules-Based Automation (RBA) action called **Create Secure Link** is not available in this version.
